

PEE DEE RIVER BASIN PLANNING



PUBLIC MEETINGS

PURPOSE: Two public meetings will be held in the Pee Dee River basin to introduce a new State water planning process and to engage stakeholders in the basin.

BACKGROUND: Under the guidance of a State Planning Process Advisory Committee, the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources has created a stakeholder-driven process that will be used to develop water plans (River Basin Plans) for each of the State's eight major river basins. These plans will be developed primarily by stakeholder teams (River Basin Councils) formed in each of the eight basins. Councils will consist of up to 25 stakeholders from each basin. Upon completion, the River Basin Plans will form the foundation of a new State Water Plan.

The Pee Dee River basin is the third basin for plan development. Additional information will be provided on the application and selection process for River Basin Council (RBC) Members.
